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Scholarships:

We are offering a limited number of partial scholarships for this course on a first come, first served basis. The sooner you apply, the more likely you are to get support from us to participate! *Please note that we very rarely and only in extreme/special circumstances give someone a full scholarship!* Our scholarship budget is limited, though any amounts people pay for the course above the low end of the sliding scale go into our scholarship budget, so the budget changes over time.

To apply for a scholarship, *you must register for the course and pay the minimum deposit*, then write an application including the three elements below, and send to Jon Darby, Education Director at Horn Farm Center (fgdi@hornfarmcenter.org):

- Write a few short paragraphs explaining your situation, why you need scholarship help to attend the course, and what you plan to do with what you learn with us.
- Create and show us a rough budget and ***tell us how much you can afford to pay for the course.*** The low end of the sliding scale for this course is \$1,200 including camping, food, tuition, and all course materials. Estimate your travel costs on top of that, plus any other costs of being away for the duration of the course. Once you have that total, estimate what you can afford to pay of that and tell us, then, how much of a scholarship you are requesting from us.
- Please also consider and list in your application people in your life who might be able to help you pay for the course and what you think it would take to get them to say yes to supporting you. Let us know how we can help! *We request that all scholarship recipients participate in creating a CSE or Community Supported Educator program*, where you find people to subscribe ahead of time for a one- or two-day workshop, or some other forest garden-related activity (landscape services, design services, etc.) proceeds from which will go to fund your teacher training (more info on the CSE program can be found online: <https://hornfarmcenter.org/fgdi-cse-info>). After the training, you will then produce the workshop or perform those services for subscribers (and perhaps others). We hope that you can work with other course participants to run your workshop or do your design work or whatever, as well, that you will see the multiple functions of such an approach, and take full advantage of the support we can offer to help you fulfill this request.
