PROJECT BACKGROUND: In addition to diversifying the crops grown on the farm and improving the ecological health of the farm, this project will positively affect the health of the waterways downstream, namely, Kreutz Creek, the Susquehanna River, and eventually the Chesapeake Bay. This project includes the planting of 20 acres along the streams of the Horn Farm property. Species chosen for planting in the multifunctional riparian buffers will add revenue while improving water quality. Additional income streams will include fruits, nuts, medicinal herbs, biochar, fence posts, lumber, and bioremediation materials. Implementation will begin in 2019 and continue through 2022 with the first 6 acres to be planted in 2021. HFC will create various productive systems that can be part of a multifunctional buffer. These systems will provide various non-timber forest products as well as providing opportunities for agroforestry education. For the 2021 phase of implementation, HFC will plant six different one-acre agroforestry systems.

SCHEDULE: Implementation began in 2020 and will continue through 2022 with the first 6 acres will be planted in spring 2021
